### CALL FOR PROPOSALS

#### Goal

The Community Alcohol and Drug Action Committee (CADAC) would like to support the development of projects by school and community groups in Campbell River that improve our community.

**CADAC will consider providing funds to projects that are intended to prevent or reduce substance use and misuse, and/or promote the reduction of harm associated with substance abuse.**

#### Funding:

CADAC will offer a maximum of \$500 to each project.

#### Proposal Requirements:

CADAC requires a simple one-page proposal that should include:

- A description of the planned activities or programming
- An outline of how the requested funds will be used.

#### Proposal Preferences:

CADAC will give preference to projects which:

- Are tailored to meet the needs of a specific school or community. CADAC recognizes that the issues will be different and unique.
- Involve a high degree of student/community participation in the development and implementation of the proposal.

#### Examples of Projects:

Projects may:

- *increase awareness* within the school or community by:
  - educating people about fetal alcohol spectrum disorder with displays or presentations
  - developing a campaign that counters media that promotes substance use
- *promote action* within the school or community by:
  - organizing a campaign to reduce teen deaths connected to drinking
  - creating/maintaining a safe community

- building refusal skills
- *encourage participation* within the school or community by:
  - organizing school or community competitions
  - hosting health promoting events
- *focus on one or more particular substances.*

### **Final Report:**

Following project completion, CADAC expects the submission of a summary report that details the exact use of the funding and includes a brief evaluation of the project that outlines the successes and challenges associated with the project. CADAC will confirm the date of submission for the Final Report based on the individual project timelines.

### **Timeline:**

This year, National Addictions Awareness Week is the week of November 15-21. Proposal activities could occur that week or may include several activities that may occur before June 30, 2010.
